

# HOW TO INTEGRATE 100MENTORS

## DISCUSSION TOPICS

We, as teachers, are always looking for educationally informed ways to bring technology in our classroom, integrate inquiry into everyday lessons and improve the quality of our students' questions. Here's how:

### TEACHER

#### 1 Create a Topic

**Create a topic** on the 100mentors app or 100mentors web platform, based on the course section you teach. Your topic should be limited within your current instructional scopes, but also allow students to expand.



### STUDENT

#### 2 Submit questions

**Set the pace** by submitting a question on the 100mentors app. Encourage students to follow your example and submit focused and sophisticated questions for the given topic.



**Make suggestions** on the features of a good question, such as accuracy, consistency, and sense of wonderment.



### STUDENT & TEACHER

#### 3 Watch the answers

**Prompt your students** to watch all answers received within the topic or schedule some time to watch the answers as a class activity. Encourage inquiry learning through further research on aspects that seem particularly interesting to them.



**Initiate a discussion** for the answers you agree to "like": choose answers that add to the instruction, the expansion of knowledge, and the approach of different perspectives.

## LIVE SESSIONS

Our students have started enhancing their learning through their inquiry-based interaction with qualified mentors within an attractive digital environment. We can offer our students the chance to advance this experience further, by having a live conversation with the world's greatest minds. Here's how:

### TEACHER

#### 1 Schedule a live session

**Deepen the discussion** with mentors that provided intriguing answers or with new mentors, now that thoughts have been triggered. Place a request for a live session for further interaction between them and your class on the topic at hand.



### STUDENT & TEACHER

#### 2 Set a session agenda

**Elaborate on the discussion** subject with more challenging questions by the students for the mentor. Ask students to submit their questions on the planned session page, thus empowering them to set the agenda themselves for the upcoming live session.



### STUDENT & TEACHER

#### 3 Participate in a live session

**Challenge your students** to actively participate in the live session, and take the role of a moderator during their conversation with the invited mentor. After the session, resume the discussion and comment on the advantages of connecting with real-world experts.
